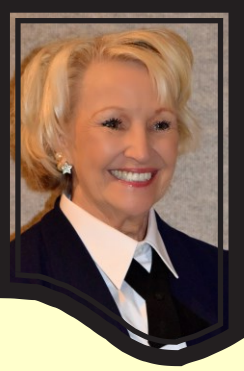

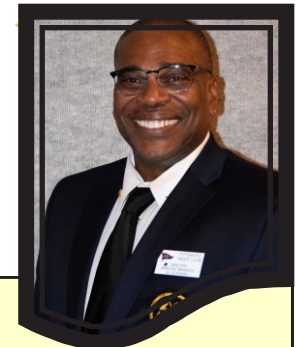

If you haven't been down for the Wednesday night dinner, you are encouraged to join! Great food, good times, and of course the members are the best!

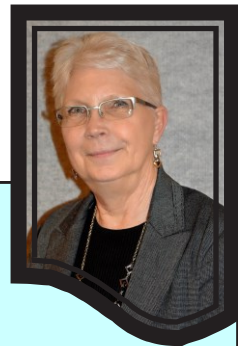
