

Greetings fellow Pittsburg Yacht club members!

Strict vaccine mandates in Contra Costa County are in effect,

Help prevent the spread of COVID-19

- Wear a mask to protect yourself and others and stop the spread of COVID-19.
- Stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arm lengths) from others who don't live with you.
- Avoid crowds and poorly ventilated spaces. The more people you are in contact with, the more likely you are to be exposed to COVID-19.
- Get a COVID-19 vaccine when it's available to you.
- Clean your hands often, either with soap and water for 20 seconds or a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.



BOATING WITH JOAN (JOANIE) MARSH

I began my interview with Joanie Marsh by asking a simple question. How many yachting organizations are you currently involved in Joanie? Joanie took a breath, and began—"Well, I'm not sure, but I'll begin by naming them to you and we can count them together!"

And the organizations—like alphabet soup—spilled out of Joanie's mouth

and onto my note pad and we began the count.

"PYC, yes that's our very own Pittsburg Yacht Club, since 1979! And there's the CCC (California Carver Club) and the PCYA (Pacific Coast Yachting Association) and the RBOC (Recreational Boaters of California) and the PICYA (Pacific Inter-Club Yacht Association) and the PYCE (PYC-Enterprises)."

She paused and then warned me, "Leave room as I may have forgotten one or two... oh yes.... I remember," Joanie interjected smiling... The **IOBG** (International Organization of the Blue Gavel). That's the fraternal order of past Commodores. What does that bring the count to now?"

Seven!

Since then, she has shared other organizations with me, I'll save that for our next article on this powerhouse!

It was 1974 when Joanie, her husband and children bought their first boat. It was a 17-foot Runabout.

It was perfect for their family. Their son was a Boy Scout, and they took the boat camping with them enjoying the nearby reservoirs.

In 1978, it was time for a bigger boat. One Sunday morning they opened their newspaper and found an ad for a boat in Pittsburg. They had no idea where Pittsburg California was, and Joanie recalls the drive from their home in Los Gatos to Pittsburg took forever! In fact, they exited Highway 4, and asked someone walking on the sidewalk where Railroad Avenue might be! Luckily, it was the next stop. They arrived at Shed 3 at the Pittsburg Marina, and it was love at first sight. A big, huge 22-foot Bayliner Nisqually! The plan was to get a trailer and pull it around like they did the 17-foot Runabout, but that never happened!

Joanie had a faraway look in her sparkling eyes as she continued.

"That boat shrank in the water instantly!! ". She announced smiling. "Of course, with two adults, and the two children, and naturally, their 2 friends, the boat was too small before we knew it!"

Within six months they were heading over to the Bayliner dealer on Bethel Island. They happily traded their 22 foot - for a 28-

foot Bayliner!

All of the friends they had made in the previous six months in shed three greeted them as they brought their new Bayliner home. When they tied up and plugged in, the lights didn't work. Just the start of another story with this "star-crossed" vessel.

Around 1983, Joanie found her "keeper".

Hull number 22, a 38-foot Bayliner was Joanie's pride and joy for 23 years.

In 2006, Joanie went to her first Carver, it was a 41-foot beauty named "GONIEGO IV". This was the final of the four boats that carried Joanie's pet name... yes, another story!

Our Joanie does not "half-mast" anything. Currently at the Pittsburg Yacht Club, Joanie holds the titles of parliamentarian, chair of the budget and finance committee, and member of the bylaws committee. She has been the PYC Commodore twice, 1988 and 1996. Within the clubs she's involved in, Joanie is currently serving on, or has served as—the treasurer, the past commodore, the president, the past president, the vice commodore, the past district director, and currently preparing to be inducted as PICYA Commodore for 2022.

On January 22, 2022, our Joanie will be officially installed as the 2022 Commodore for the PICYA. It will be a grand event, and everyone is invited to attend. (See the flyer in this **YEOMAN** for all the details!)




