

We have an engaging and experienced teacher who teaches by the book - as well as his own 30 plus years' experience in the Oakland Fire Department.



A **BIG THANK YOU** to everyone involved. With the continued support of all of our members, we can only continue to improve!




We have lots of activities to enjoy and for our members to get involved in. The more you get involved the more fun you will have!

There being no further business to attend to the meeting was adjourned at 8:20 pm.


