Steve led a work crew installing a new storage shed. Steve was always at the club working on ways to improve the operations of the club.

Steve and his wife Chris were always top contenders for best dressed awards during Western Night and Halloween themed parties. They often won first place in a number of categories. One year Steve and Chris paid for Hawaiian dancers to entertain club members during a luau.

Steve was always ready to lend a helping hand whether it be at the club or another members personal projects. His friendly nature and many talents will always be remembered at PYC. He was always roaming around the club talking with people about their interests. Steve was such a fun and engaging guy he will be dearly missed.

- Repaired several GFI outlets in kitchen
- Replaced several circuit breakers in kitchen electrical panel
- Boosted up sagging floor in dining room

- Designed and installed a complete stereo system
- Replaced broken women's shower faucet
- Replaced men's bathroom sink faucet
- Replaced men's shower fixture
- Installed sewer gas traps in both bathrooms
- Replaced several corroded sewer connections under the club
- Painted and replaced wood paneling in front, around ramp
- Cleaned and waxed the dance floor
- All new LED lighting in club...with help from Joe Dopart
- Installed all new wash/rinse fixtures in kitchen
- Replaced the heating elements and fans in the warming oven
- Installed a digital temp indicator in warmer
- Designed a new electronic temp controller for the reach in refrigerator
- Installed temp indicators in both ovens
- Replaced all florescent light covers in kitchen
- Repaired the ceiling that caved in in the pantry
- Cleaned the inside of the oven hood + filters
- Replaced broken light fixture in the ceiling of women's shower


