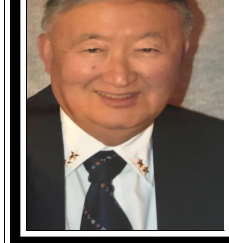

The bar continued to be very busy in February and March. Recent top grossing events at the bar were the Blue Gavel induction luncheon, corn beef and cabbage dinner, Wednesday night dinners, member and non-member rentals for birthdays, memorials and weddings. Some of the newer bar drinks continue to sell well including Don Julio Anejo 70 and Stella Artois.

Margo and I completed and passed the Licensee Education on Alcohol and Drugs class and exam conducted by the ABC. The class was offered on February 20, 2019 in Benicia.

As noted during the general meeting, the bar prices for non-member rentals were raised by \$1 for a glass of wine, beer, mixed drinks and straight liquor and an equivalent amount for a bottle of wine or champagne.

The soda and mix guns need to be serviced or replaced. We are evaluating a proposal by Reyes Bottling, who will provide a field assessment and service if we set up an account to buy Coke products. They will calibrate the blend for the sodas in the guns to produce a commercial grade coke product. Reyes has accounts with Discovery Bay, Sportsmen and Martinez Yacht Clubs. Reyes can provide syrups for coke, diet coke, sprite, cranberry, sprite zero and ginger ale plus tonic water out of the gun. The eventual switch from cans of soda to the guns will greatly facilitate the operations at the bar and eliminate numerous trips to retail stores to buy cans of soda.

Looking forward is the Dan O'Connor Memorial Corn Beef and Cabbage Dinner and Opening Day on the Delta. Look for more fabulous creations by the decorating committee for the corn beef and cabbage dinner. Maybe "that guy" will dress up for us again this year!! There may even be some surprise entertainment by Peter Dragula.

Please remember your volunteer bartenders who work hard to provide you with great service. A lot of their work occurs outside regular bar hours in order to provide your favorite beverage and great snacks as an added bonus (watch for flyers and emails announcing food, snacks or munchies at the bar).

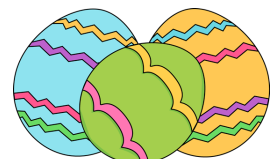

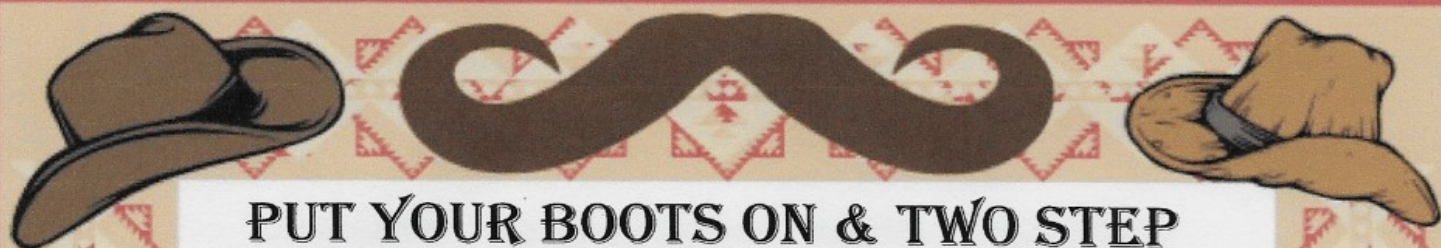

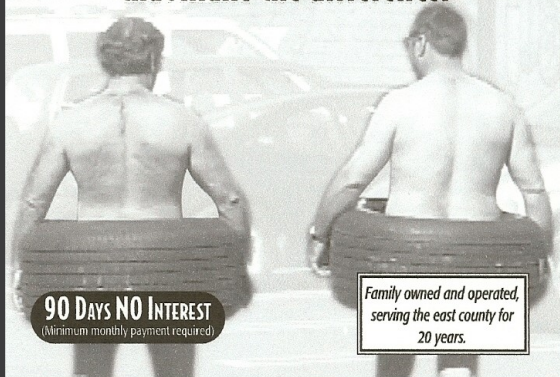
