We had a new member sign up in February and I am anxious to introduce him at the March General meeting.

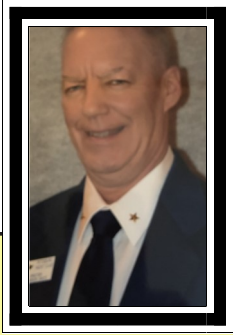

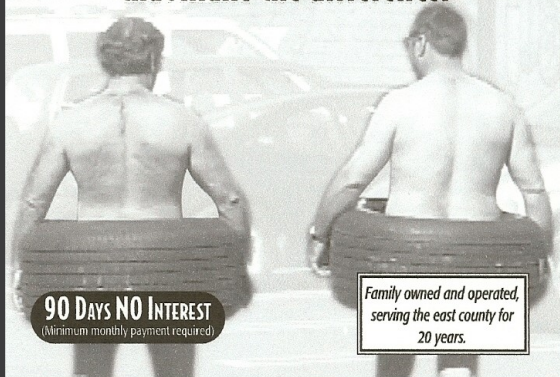
