On Wednesdays, we still need to clean up after ourselves and the caterer, which is usually just utensils.

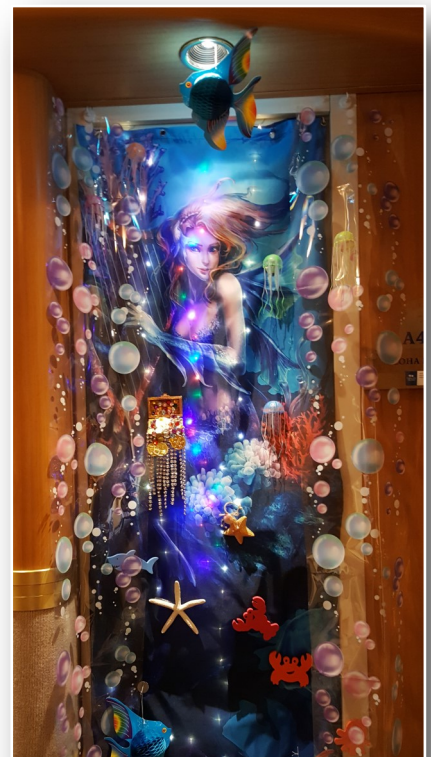
To keep all dinners a good quality and to continue having Ernie on Friday nights, it will be necessary to raise our prices by a few dollars.

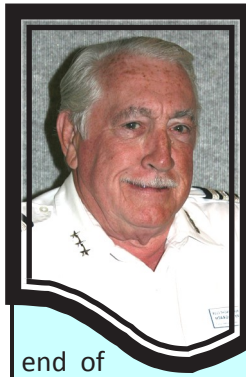

Vice Commodore Gary McGrath: Gary reported the income in December from the bar and reported what the profit margin was. He also reported on the year to date bar income and average monthly sales net profit for the year. His reported on what his percentage goal per month throughout the all year is.

Port Captain Samantha Fox: Samantha reported that San Francisco Bay Area Nordic Tug Group (the "Tuggers") loved their stay at Pittsburg Yacht Club. In the year ahead, she has received a deposit from Sacramento Yacht Club for a July cruise-in. Discovery Bay Yacht Club has given a deposit for 30 boats, Sea Food Festival in September. She has ten cruise-ins scheduled for 2018 so far, and Bridge Marina will be arriving on Friday, February 9 - 11 for their first overnight cruise-in of the new year. The Sea Ray Club has booked for the crab feed in February, and March reservations are wide open at the moment. April 14 is opening day on the Delta and Benicia Yacht Club has booked 15-18 boats for that weekend. No theme has yet been decided. Hidden Harbor has booked in May and over the July 4th weekend, we have 30 boats coming and not enough slips available, but we will come up with something.

The proposed changed is to hold meetings January, March, May, July, September, October, November, and December. **Rich Irwin** and **Mike Miata** were added to the Bylaws committee. These appointments were approved by Committee. **Debbie Wagner** asked if the membership wanted the Yeoman to publish monthly or to coincide with the meetings. The membership agreed that the Yeoman would publish monthly and will follow the reports of committee members.
