PYCE has also been very busy with rentals.


Our Bartender Kandi and Shelly working long hours a big thank you.





**Boating Issues UpdateFebruary 21, 2018** 

Boater Funds Dedicated to Boater Programs

Boater fuel tax dollars and registration fees should be dedicated to programs and services benefiting boaters.

#### **Boating and the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta**

RBOC opposes the California WaterFix that would significantly impede navigation and harm Delta recreation.

#### **Copper- based Anti-fouling Paints**

California legislators are urged to contact the USEPA to request a long-delayed decision be made on the approv- al of the biotic ligand model for salt water, to assist in the development of site -specific findings for copper in the state's impaired water bodies.

#### **Boater Rights Aboard Their Vessels**

Legislation aimed at preventing smoking in state parks should not prohibit boaters from deciding to smoke within the confines of their own private vessels.

#### **Chemical Toilets on Boats**

Any prohibition against the sale or use of a nonbiodegradable or toxic chemical in a vessel's toilet should be predicated upon the availability of effective and affordable biodegradable chemicals for boaters.




