PYCE has also been very busy with rentals.

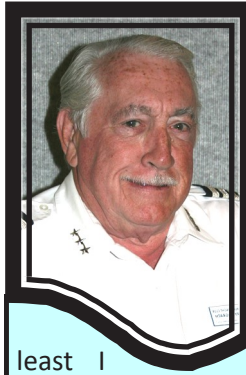
Our Bartender Kandi and Shelly working long hours a big thank you.

As always could not manage without all of you and thank you xxxx

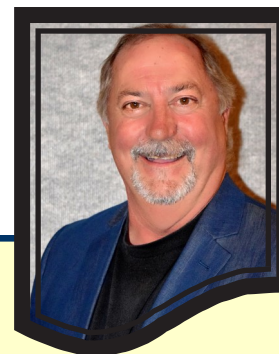

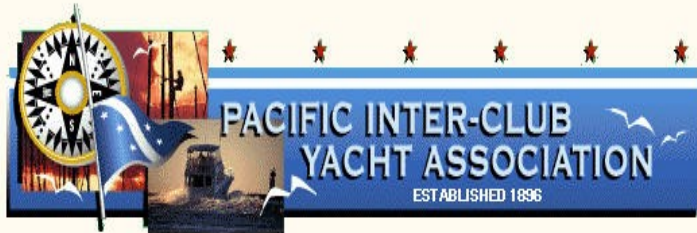

Boating Issues Update February 21, 2018

Boater Funds Dedicated to Boater Programs

Boater fuel tax dollars and registration fees should be dedicated to programs and services benefiting boaters.

Boating and the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta

RBOC opposes the California WaterFix that would significantly impede navigation and harm Delta recreation.

Copper- based Anti-fouling Paints

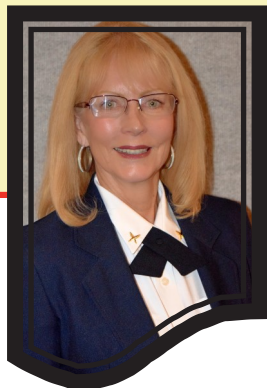
California legislators are urged to contact the USEPA to request a long-delayed decision be made on the approval of the biotic ligand model for salt water, to assist in the development of site-specific findings for copper in the state's impaired water bodies.

Boater Rights Aboard Their Vessels

Legislation aimed at preventing smoking in state parks should not prohibit boaters from deciding to smoke within the confines of their own private vessels.

Chemical Toilets on Boats

Any prohibition against the sale or use of a nonbiodegradable or toxic chemical in a vessel's toilet should be predicated upon the availability of effective and affordable biodegradable chemicals for boaters.

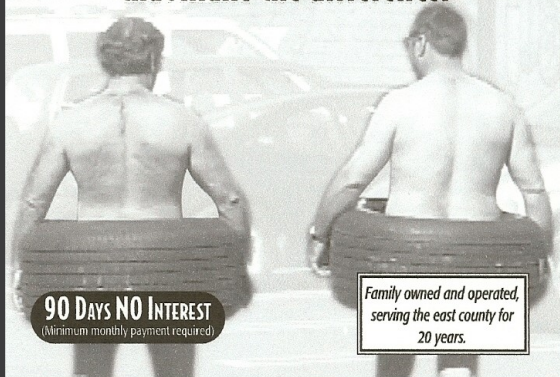
