

The Lighted Boat Parade was a huge success this year with 8 entries and well over 100 people.


More about that in next months edition. I have been awake for 24 hours. It's now 4 AM and I am wide awake.

PITTSBURG YACHT CLUB, INC. BYLAW ----- PROPOSED CHANGES

ARTICLE V - ELECTION OF OFFICERS & DIRECTORS

Section 2

Nomination of Officers and Directors shall be as follows:

In the month of March, the Commodore shall appoint a Nominating Committee Chair and four (4) regular Members, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.

The Committee shall be-call for Nominees and publish the Call in the July 1st Yeoman. The report of the committee shall be presented to the Board at the July meeting, and upon approval, publish the nominees in the September Yeoman. prior to the regular Club meeting in September. Nominations from the floor will be accepted at the September general meeting.

Following the September general meeting, there shall be a Notice of Candidates Nominated and published in the Yeoman prior to the election. Election of officers will be held on the second Friday in October.

For each election of officers and Directors, an official ballot shall be prepared. The ballot shall also have blank spaces equal to the number of officers and Directors to be elected at the election, so that voting Members may write in the names of other Members in good standing for whom they wish to vote.

Absentee ballots for elections will be permitted upon written request only.

Section 3

Nominating Committee

The Nominating Committee shall consist of five (5) Members in good standing including the Chair. Recommendations for candidates must have the consensus of at least three (3) of the five (5) Committee Members. The Nominating Committee shall name candidates for each vacant position. The Nominating Committee shall offer each Junior Officer the opportunity to advance to the next higher office. If the member agrees, the Nominating Committee shall include that member's name on the ballot. The Nominating Committee shall assure that each candidate meets the requirements of Article II, Section 1. Each candidate will be apprised of their duties and responsibilities for their respective position as described both in the Bylaws and the current Duties and Responsibilities document. The Nominating Committee shall submit its report to the Board of Directors at their July meeting. It is recommended that the Nominating Committee and Election Committee members are not from the same Membership.

Election Committee

The Commodore shall appoint three (3) Members in good standing, one of whom should be the Chair appointed

by the Commodore and none of whom were on the current Nominating Committee. The eligible Members will be approved by the Board of Directors.

Both the Nominating and Election Committees will be responsible for implementing the rules as outlined in under the most current Duties and Responsibilities document, for each respective committee.

ARTICLE VI – OFFICERS

Section 1

The officers of the Club shall consist of the Commodore, Vice Commodore, Rear Commodore, Port Captain, Fleet Captain, Secretary and Treasurer. The immediate past Commodore shall be designated as Staff Commodore.

For the purpose of these Bylaws, the following requirements shall govern the positions of Commodore, Vice Commodore and Rear Commodore.

Commodore: Shall have served in two (2) prior chairs as a flag officer or Director.

Vice Commodore: Shall have served in two (2) prior chairs as a flag officer or Director.

Rear Commodore: Shall have served a term in one (1) calendar year prior chair as a flag officer or Director. The one (1) calendar year shall be construed as starting January 01 of the current year and ending December 31 of the current year. If the nominees will have filled his or her current year as a Flag Officer or Director by December 31 of the current year, they are eligible for nomination for the next year's office.

For Vice Commodore and Rear Commodore, "Director" may also include experience as an Officer or Director of PYC Enterprises. The person must also be a Member in good standing of Pittsburg Yacht Club.

For the purposes of these Bylaws, all officers shall be designated as flag officers, one of whom shall be the immediate past Commodore. The Staff Commodore's position is held by the prior year's Commodore.

The Board of Directors shall consist of the aforementioned seven officers, plus the Staff Commodore, and six elected Directors.

Section 2

The Rear Commodore:

- (3) The <u>Chair of the Galley Committee</u> shall be supervised by the Rear Commodore and will be responsible for maintaining the total interior area of the Galley, including all storage areas', pots & pans, silverware, utility tools, Garbage cans & bags, Countertops, Cleaning of Freezers, Refrigerators, Warmers, Grease tanks; Exhaust hood & back wall of grill & ovens; Floors; Lighting; Janitorial sink & equipment.
- (4) Coordinate with PYC event chairs to maintain all interior setups appropriate for all functions, including moving tables & chairs, in & out of storage. Select a group of members to assist with furniture movements.
- (5) Keep informed about arrangements for the private member and non-member event usage of the facility by PYC enterprises, Inc

The Secretary

(5) Shall maintain an accurate, current copy of the club documents:

Bylaws, Duties & Responsibilities and House Rules.

The Board of Directors

- (1) General Powers of the Board of Directors: The Board shall have the responsibility for management of the business of the Corporation, and subject to the restrictions imposed by law, by the Articles of Incorporation, or by these Bylaws, may exercise all of the powers of the corporation. Board members may shall be provided key access to the Clubhouse and a Security code number.
- (2) Specific Powers of the Board of Directors: Without prejudice to such general powers, it is hereby expressly declared that the Board shall have the following powers:
 - (a) To adopt and alter a common seal of corporation.
 - (b) To make and change regulations consistent with these Bylaws for the management of the corporation's business and affairs.

Section 6

Manage, update and post in the bar area, the document known as "House Rules," that defines the day-to-day operations and conduct for members and guests.

ARTICLE XIII - STANDING RULES

Section 1

<u>Duties and Responsibilities Document</u>: It is the intent of this document to further define specific the duties, procedures and rules to follow for <u>officers</u>, committees and delegates, and also contains guidelines to be followed in the performance of their respective positions.

Any changes to the document shall be submitted to the Bylaws Committee for review and recommendations and then approved by the Board of Directors. and accepted by the Membership, providing there are no conflicts with the Bylaws of the Club.

Section 2

A current copy of Duties of Responsibilities shall be maintained by the Club Secretary and shall be distributed to members in good standing, via <u>Yahoo Group Email</u>, excluding Facebook, any time changes are approved;

ARTICLE XIV- INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE

Section 4

Responsibility for Review of Coverages

It shall be an obligation of the Board of Directors to review annually, in March, the full Insurance coverage for all functions of PYC and PYC Enterprises Inc, to insure proper policies are maintained and adequately cover all of the various risks.




