PROPOSED CHANGES TO PYC BYLAWS

Approved by the Board of Directors May 29, 2019 Presented in the July YEOMAN for Membership approval on August 9, 2019 Words with <u>black bold underline</u> are new; Words deleted are red strike-out (informed)

MEMBERSHIP ARTICLE II

Section 2

All Members are responsible for any and all-actions of their guests at all Club functions. Members must accompany guests as long as guests remain on premises. <u>Members may entertain the same</u> <u>person/s a maximum of 6 times per year at any event or activity. All guests must be signed in and</u> <u>display a temporary guest badge to be served any liquor at the club.</u>

All Members and guests are expected to conduct themselves in a proper manner so as not to disrupt or impair the good name of the Club.

All Members are expected to participate in a minimum of eight (8) hours yearly in work parties, club functions, committees or other related endeavors for the benefit of PYC. This yearly duty can be scheduled at various intervals for the convenience of the Member(s). The Rear Commodore shall be responsible for coordination of these activities.

There shall be eight (8) Classifications of Membership: (1) Full Membership, (2) Individual Membership, (3) Non-Resident Membership, (4) Cruising/Traveling Membership, (5) PICYA Affiliate, (6) Temporary or Guest Membership, (7) Corporate Membership, and (8) Life Membership.

- (1) Full Membership: This is the broadest form of membership for up to two (2) voting members related as family or domestic partners. For purposes of these Bylaws, a Domestic Partnership shall be defined as two people living in the same residence. This shall include members who have minor children who will be considered part of the PYC family. Full memberships will pay any Initiation Fee upon application and will pay Full dues and any assessment levied. This membership will have members' names and contact information included in the roster and will receive official name tags for both members. Full Memberships will have full privileges (voting, hold office and serve on any committee) and privileges for the use of the clubhouse during regular club hours and may participate in an unlimited number of club-sponsored dinners and events. A Full Membership may be considered for a change to Individual Membership status, due to family reasons, by submitting a request to the Board. If granted, dues will not be refunded, but revert to the single fee at the beginning of the next calendar year
- (2) Individual Membership: This is membership for an individual for one (1) voting member. <u>An Individual Membership is not available to persons who are married or part of a</u> <u>domestic partnership.</u> Individual memberships will pay any Initiation Fee upon application and individual dues and any assessment levied. An Individual Membership will have the same

club privileges as Full Members. An Individual Membership may be upgraded to add another person to the Membership by making a pro-rated payment of the difference in dues between the two classifications (Individual and Full).

Exceptions to this rule may be considered by a written request to the Board.

ARTICLE VI OFFICERS

Section 2

The Rear Commodore

(1) Shall be the primary person in charge of repairing, maintaining or coordinating contract vendors for <u>all</u> <u>of</u> the facility systems. <u>Air Conditioners</u>, <u>Thermostats and controls</u>; <u>Hot Water heaters</u>; <u>All plumbing</u>, <u>Toilets & sinks</u>; <u>Fire extinguishers and Sprinkler system</u>; <u>Security system</u>; <u>Galley equipment</u>: <u>such as</u> <u>Dishwashers & Dispensers</u>; <u>Ovens & Grills</u>; <u>Freezers & Refrigerators</u>; <u>General storage areas and drawers</u>; <u>Trash disposal materials</u>; <u>Rug Shampooing</u>, <u>as needed</u>; <u>Select</u>, define job duties and supervise the contracted Janitorial Vendor <u>for interior areas of the facility</u>.

(2) Shall be supervisor of the Chair of the Building & Grounds Committee, <u>appointed by the Commodore</u>, which will be responsible to maintain the exterior portions of the facility..., for both short & long term features such as: Weekly Sweeping of all walks & decks; Maintain all fencing, railings, trash disposal area and deck surfaces; Maintain & Repair as needed, all storage spaces; Trim hedges & remove weeds; For enterior of building, wash windows, eaulk and paint or recommend when needed; Stain & Clean railings as needed around the building; Maintain proper storage of all Tables & Chairs.

(3) <u>Shall be supervisor of the Chair of the Galley Committee, appointed by the Commodore</u>, which and will be responsible for maintaining the total interior area of the Galley. <u>including all storage areas</u>, pots & pans, silverware, utility tools, Garbage cans & bags, Countertops, Cleaning, of Freezers, Refrigerators, Warmers, Grease tanks; Hood & back wall of grill & ovens; Floors; Lighting; Janitorial sink & equipment.

(4) <u>Shall coordinate with PYC event chairs to maintain all interior setups appropriate for all functions, including moving tables & chairs, in & out of storage. Select a group of members to assist with furniture movements.</u>

(5) <u>Shall coordinate with PYC Enterprises, Inc</u> about arrangements for the private member and nonmember event usage of <u>the facility.</u>

(6) Shall coordinate with Port Captain, as needed, to facilitate PICYA cruise-ins clubs.

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
