Vallejo will be cruising in for the 3rd time this year (yeah) on Thursday, the 24th of October with nine boats and leaving on Friday morning.

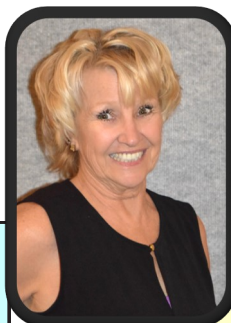
Bridge Marina are joining us for Sue McDaniels annual Chili Cook-off. If it's as much fun as last years it will be a blast, so it's a must!

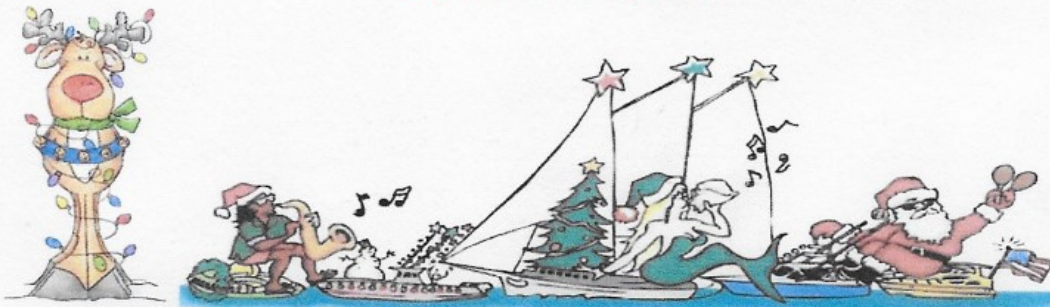

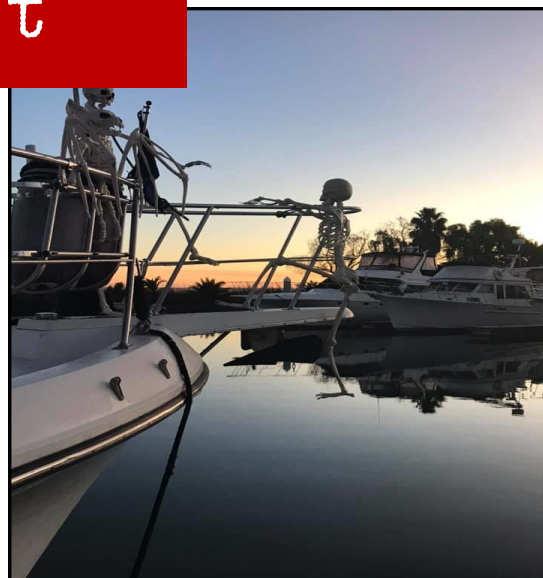

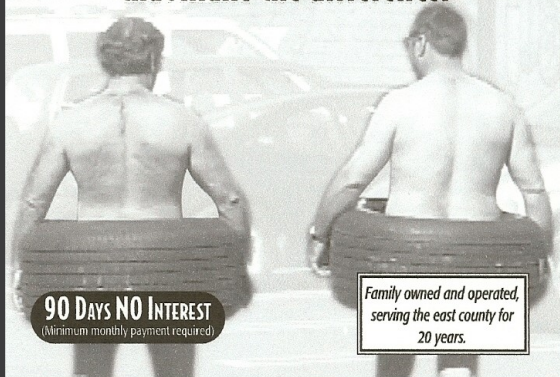
