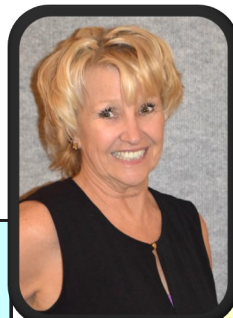

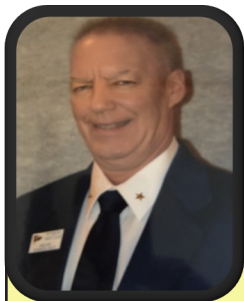

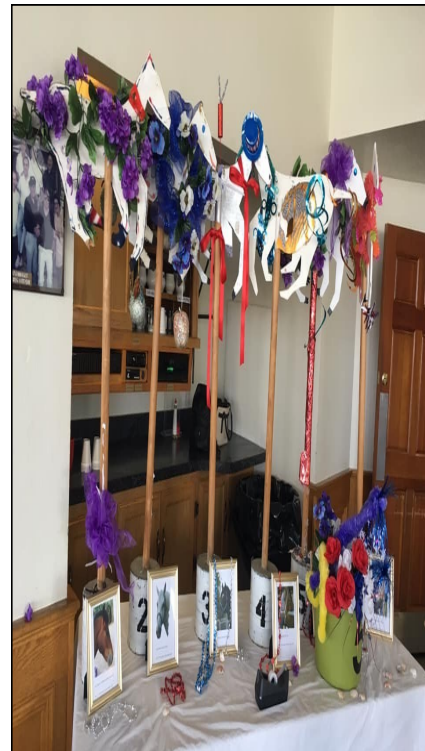
At the September Membership meeting I was pleased to announce the following new members:

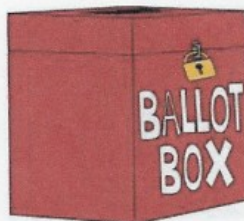

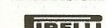
