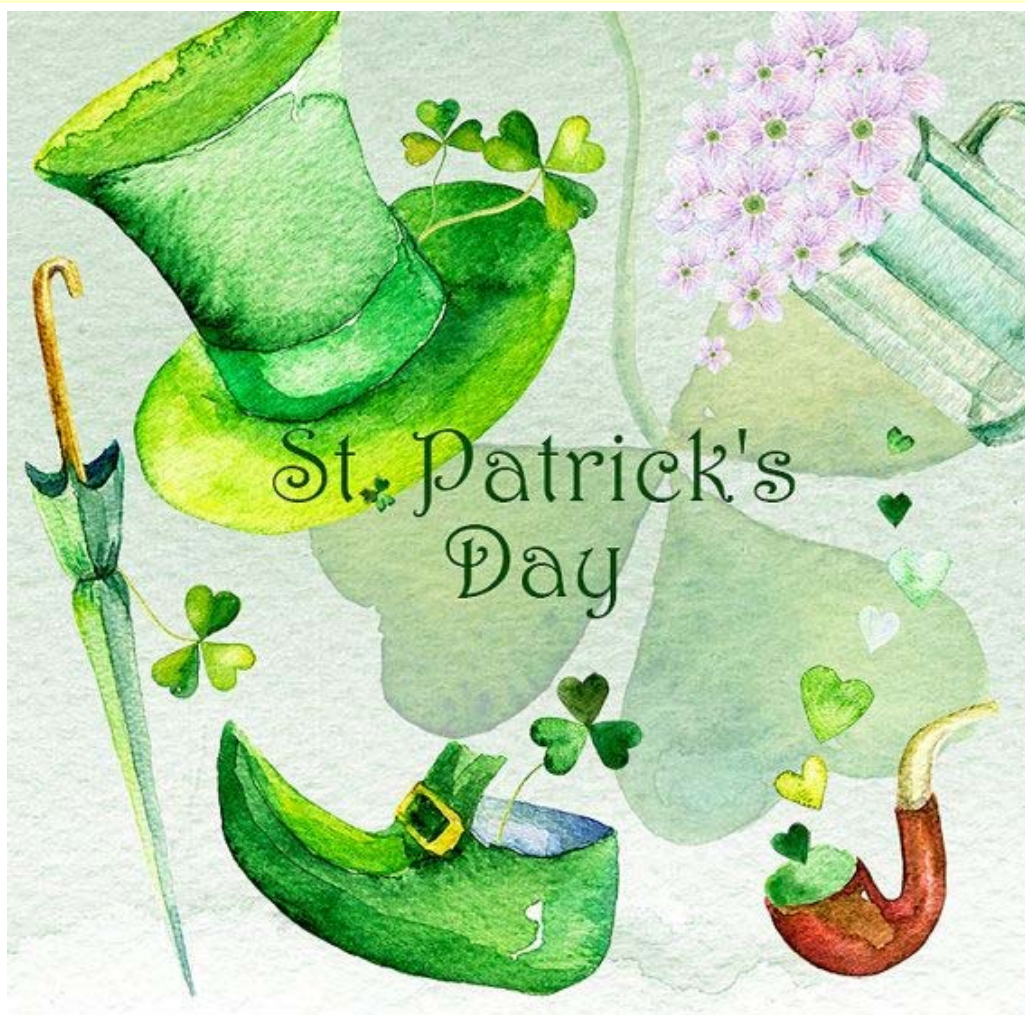

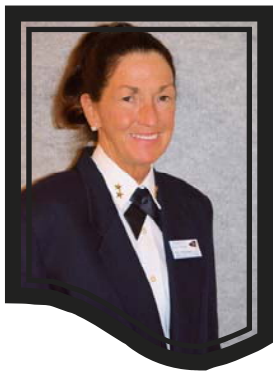

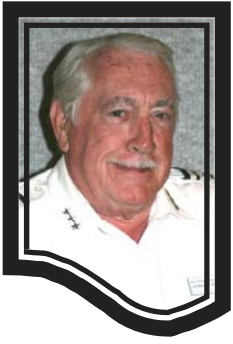

February was a very busy month at the club. There were 4 rentals and 2 club activities. Lots of events mean that the dining room and bar furniture gets moved around a lot. I greatly appreciate the efforts of **Shannon Davis, John Salazar, Richard Hardy, Dick Butler** and **Richard Howell** in helping me to get this done.

I have appointed **Evie Dopart** to the new position of Galley Manager. She is well-known (55 years) to me as a great galley manager. She needs a kitchen crew to help her in the task of shaping-up our galley. Although she already has a couple of volunteers, she needs more help. Please volunteer.

A start has been made to the goal of improving the appearance and functionalism of the facility at little or no cost to the club treasury. With respect to the major repair of replacing some deteriorated siding to the outside of our building, \$440.00 has been raised through two raffles of beautiful Afghans created by our Commodore **Mary Jo Sullivan**.

On the to do list of other than major items, **George Grech** and I (1) installed a safety chain to safely secure carbon dioxide gas cylinders used by the bar, (2) reinforced the supply shed door and installed a lock hasp on it, (3) installed a battery-powered light in the supply shed and (4) installed a new doorstop on the galley outside door. **George** also repaired the damaged sign for the Commodore's parking spot and installed it in place.

Rich Hardy also secured, in place, a new Bartenders parking spot sign.

John Salazar climbed way up on that big, very tall step-ladder and replaced the burned out light bulbs in the dining room.

All of these parts were donated or already at the club.

My thanks to **Craig Schoenthaler**, he found and donated a piece of rebar to be used to ring the dinner bell. Another metal bar, origin unknown, has also shown up at the dinner bell site. Both bars work great. (Thanks to wherever or whomever the other bar came from).

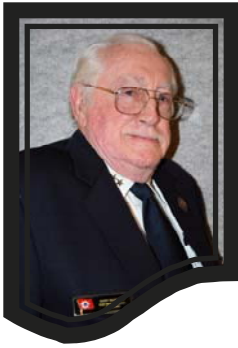

SAFETY GROUP SCHOLARSHIP
PROGRAM



PURPOSE:

PICYA awards scholarships to graduating high school students or college students wishing to continue their education in approved institutions of higher learning.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be considered applicants must be:

- ‰ Students whose parents, grandparents, guardians or mentors are members of a yacht club belonging to PICYA
- ‰ Applicants must be graduating high school seniors of the current year, or college students continuing to pursue their educational goals.
- ‰ Scholarships are not renewable. However, previous recipients are eligible to reapply, provided they still meet all other qualifications.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

The availability of scholarships to award each year is dependent upon donations.

1. Traditionally the "Worldwide Boaters Safety Group", sponsored by the Norman-Spencer Insurance Agency has generously provided from one to three scholarships each year.
2. Members of the P.I.C.Y.A. clubs can donate memorial scholarships.
3. Member clubs of the P.I.C.Y.A make donation to the Foundation specifying the intent is to help fund scholarships.

FUNDING:

The funding for the scholarships is administered by the "P.I.C.Y.A Scholarship Foundation", funded from contributions donated to the Scholarship fund. Members may make tax deductible donations.

1. A full memorial scholarship requires \$2,700 to fund.
2. Smaller donations may be made to help fund general scholarships.
3. A donation of \$250 earns the donators Yacht Club 10 COTY points.

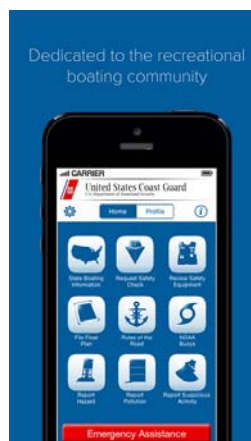
BOATING SAFETY ED STETSON

The official U.S. Coast Guard app gives you 24/7 access to the most commonly requested information and resources for the recreational boating public.

With the U.S. Coast Guard app, you can:

- « Identify the boating safety laws, requirements and resources available in your home state, the state where you keep your vessel or the state where you are planning to operate.
- « Request a vessel safety check from the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary.
- « Determine what safety equipment you are required to carry by law based on the size and type of vessel you are operating. The app also recommends additional safety equipment you might want to consider.
- « File a float plan with up to three friends, loved ones or other responsible parties. While you cannot file a float plan directly with the Coast Guard, the app helps you develop a float plan that will allow your responsible party to provide search and rescue coordinators with important information they can use to facilitate a missing or overdue boater case.
- « Review the most commonly sought out navigational “rules of the road.”
- « Access weather information from the closest NOAA buoy to your current location.
- « Report a navigational hazard to the Coast Guard – this could be a buoy or marker out of place, a sunken vessel or some other obstacle obstructing safe passage of a Federal waterway.
- « Report pollution to the Coast Guard – from a minor oil sheen at the dock to a major pollution event, you can help protect our marine environment.
- « Report suspicious activity to the Coast Guard – if you see something, say something! We all have a shared responsibility for homeland security.



While the U.S. Coast Guard app will help you better prepare for your time on the water and may help you contact the Coast Guard in an emergency, it is not a replacement for a VHF-FM marine radio, EPIRB, safe boating classes and common sense. Learn more about being a responsible boater at <http://www.uscgboating.org/>.

The U.S. Coast Guard app is a self-contained mobile application that resides solely on your mobile device. Information about yourself, your vessel and your current or past locations is only shared with the Coast Guard when you choose to do so.
