

Reminder: Payment for 2020 membership renewals are due by the end of March.



I'm here to tell you about some great ideas that our Commodore Joe has brought to my attention. We're bringing back members to cook on Wednesday nights. It will be great to have our members participate in cooking. We will be introducing taco night every 2nd Wednesday.

I will be putting together some cooking classes to show how to cook and shop for 30 to 50 people. 


